

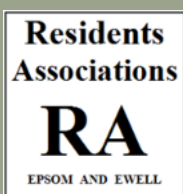

Our top 6 priorities for Epsom West

Fix and improve our roads, pathways and public transport connectivity

We will work hard to ensure our roads, pathways and verges are safe and kept in good repair and any problems speedily dealt with. We will emphasise forward planning over reactive works. We will seek to establish a three action "Rapid response" plan:

- Reinststate Local Highway Officers who have a good knowledge of our roads and will report potholes for immediate repair.
- Find and Fix (Not report and wait). We will replace the current slow process with more agile Find and Fix crews.
- Get advice from Specialists for Permanent Fixes to ensure a 'Right First Time' repair that lasts years, not weeks.

We will also seek the introduction of No Pavement Parking Zones in our High Streets and residential roads to eliminate inconsiderate motorcycle and car parking on our streets. We will press for better planning for improved bus, rail, road, cycle and pedestrian infrastructure.

Feeling Safe

We see how concerned residents are about increasing anti-social behaviours particularly in the Town Centre.

We will work with our local police and agencies to reduce anti-social behaviour and ensure we keep Epsom a safe, clean, family friendly environment.

Supporting our local economy

We will work hard to keep Epsom a thriving local market town making it a 'go to' place to live and visit. We will work with the Epsom Business Improvement District (BID) organisation to create a more vibrant shopping and leisure experience to encourage the longer term economic vitality of our town.

Protect our green spaces

We have some wonderful green spaces in our area. We will fight to keep these including the allotments. We need to have a credible local plan to manage development. We want to keep Epsom Town clean and green. We will ensure that unauthorised encampments are dealt with quickly.



Improved local support for children and young people with Special Educational Needs (SEND)

We will aim to improve the provision of 'closer to home' SEND places for Epsom and Ewell families.

Improved local health services

We will work with our local health partners to campaign for better local health services including improving our local hospitals and fight hard for the building of a new hospital for our residents.
